HOUSING PROGRAMS:

Our housing programs offer supportive services with the goal of helping our participants and their families reach sustainable self-reliance.

FAMILY EMERGENCY SHELTER

Shelters 20 families with 100 beds

3 meals served daily

Call: 2-1-1 and dial 8

PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

Serves those affected by chronic homelessness and those with disabilities

PSH is made up of 3 HUD funded programs which provide subsidized housing for over 200 households

HOME AT LAST

Serves seniors 55+

OMEGA

Serves individuals and families

STEP UP SACRAMENTO

127 units serving individuals and families

MATHER COMMUNITY CAMPUS

Serves former foster youth ages 18-25

Serves single adults for up to 9 months

3 meals served daily

Required 2-1-1 assessment over the phone during the hours of 7:30am-11:00pm Monday – Friday.
